

If you receive an error such as
“The program can’t start because **d3dx9_43.dll** is missing from your computer”

install the “DirectX End-User Runtimes (June 2010)” package from Microsoft

Search for Microsoft DirectX End-User Runtimes June 2010 in Google and it should lead you to the
official Microsoft page

On finding and downloading the package, it will ask where to put it, you can just create a new folder
on the desktop and download to there (You can delete it after its been used)

Once you’ve downloaded the files go into the folder and double click the ‘DXSETUP’ application, this
will add the missing files.

Once this is done you can delete the folder and the game should run!
